

Cat sitter instructions

Feeding, litter, hiding places, handling, carriers and escape safety.

CAT AND ROUTINE

Cat name, age and useful description

Pip, 4-year-old black-and-white domestic shorthair.

Meals, water and treats

Half a labelled pouch at 08:00 and 18:00. Refresh kitchen and upstairs bowls.

Litter routine and waste location

Scoop morning and evening; bags in the utility cupboard.

Play, sleep and familiar hiding places

Likes wand play after dinner; may sleep behind the armchair.

HANDLING AND SAFETY

Indoor or outdoor rule

Indoor only.

Door, window and escape risks

Keep utility-room window closed and check Pip is clear before opening the front door.

Handling, greeting and settling preferences

Let Pip approach. Do not pull her from a hiding place.

Carrier location and safe transport note

Carrier open in utility room; familiar towel inside.

Current medication or None

None.

CONTACTS AND HANDOVER

Owner and agreed backup

Alex first; Sam is the agreed local backup.

Regular vet and out-of-hours route

Checked practice number; voicemail gives the current emergency provider.

Supply locations, updates and return checks

Food and litter beside the sink. Send an evening update and check windows.

IMPORTANT

Respect the cat's established indoor, handling and veterinary instructions. Never force contact with a hiding cat.
